**BY-LAW NO. 694-9**

**BY-LAW MODIFYING BY-LAW NO. 694  
CONCERNING TRAFFIC**

---

**WHEREAS** a notice of motion of the present By-law was given at the regular council meeting held on December 5, 2016;

**ON JANUARY 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017, THE COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:**

1. By-law no. 694 is further modified by replacing article 15 with the following:

CHAPTER XV

OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMIT

- 15.1 In this Chapter, the word “permit” means to register a vehicle with the Town and pay the required fees.
- 15.2 A permit is issued to anyone justifying that he or she is a resident of a building where Council is authorizing “overnight parking”.
- 15.3 An employee referred to in paragraph 15.2 may cancel a permit if the person to whom it has been issued no longer meets the requirements of paragraph 15.2.
- 15.4 If a sticker is needed, it must be affixed on the inside of the top centre of the rear window of the vehicle for which it is issued.
- 15.5 It is prohibited to park a vehicle without a proper permit on any street or part of any street where parking is prohibited except for permit holders, or those with temporary permission.
- 15.6 Independently of whether or not the owner or lessee of a vehicle possesses an overnight parking permit, parking is prohibited even for permit holders when the Public Works Department or their duly authorized representatives have placed temporary signs prohibiting parking to allow the execution of roadwork, including snow removal or for any other reason of necessity or emergency.

In the event that a vehicle is parked, with or without a permit, when temporary signs are posted at least twelve hours prior to the time the vehicle was parked, the owner or lessee of the vehicle is liable for a fine of \$30 plus costs. The Director of Public Security, or his duly authorized representative, shall have the authority to tow the vehicle and the owner or lessee shall pay costs for towing.

15.7 General Rules

- 15.7.1 No more than three annual permits may be issued for the same residence.

- 15.7.2 An employee, authorized by the Town to issue a permit, may request the person to whom it is issued to provide evidence that he or she ~~still~~ meets the requirements for the issuance of such permit.
- 15.7.3 A permit is not transferable and is not refundable.
- 15.7.4 If a person to whom a permit has been issued no longer meets the requirements for holding such permit, he or she must notify the Town.
- 15.7.5 Annual permits are issued only to those residents who have insufficient combined parking space, in their driveway and garage, to accommodate their vehicles.
- 15.7.6 Any change in vehicle or licence plate, including the temporary use of an alternative vehicle, must be reported to the Town Hall.
- 15.7.7 Failure to comply with the above-mentioned regulations could result in the permit being revoked, without a refund, and could also result in the issuing of a parking fine.
- 15.8 The tariffs for obtaining an overnight parking permit are established in accordance with the applicable By-law on tariffs:
- 15.8.1 Annual, monthly and weekly permit are available, all subject to the conditions of Section 15.7.
- 15.9 On the following holidays, the Town of Hampstead will be granting **overnight** parking tolerance:
- a) **Passover** – (March-April) from the first day for Nine (9) days;
  - b) **Good Friday to Easter Monday** – (March-April) – Four (4) days;
  - c) **Shavuot** – (May-June) – From the first day for three (3) days;
  - d) **Rosh Hashanah/ Yom Kippur / Succot / Simchat Torah** – (September-October) - From the first day of Rosh Hashanah to the day following Simchat Torah;
  - e) **Christmas Eve & New Year** – (December 24 to January 2) – Ten days.
- 15.10 Within a calendar year and upon request, twelve (12) overnight parking passes are available, at no cost for each civic address (conditions of Section 15.7 apply);
- 15.11 The day-time parking on both sides of Dufferin Street, within the Hampstead territory and from Ellerdale to Côte-St-Luc Road, is reserved only for the residents of the said street upon the registration of their vehicle with the Town and in accordance with the road sign.
2. The present by-law will come into effect according to the law.
