**CONSOLIDATION OF BY-LAW N° 672 AND
ITS AMENDMENT NO. 672-1 AND 672-2**

BY-LAW NO: 672

BY-LAW REGULATING
VARIOUS COMMERCIAL
ACTIVITIES

NOTICE

This consolidation is not official. It has been compiled on April 1st, 2015 by the Town Clerk in order to facilitate the reading of the text. The official text is to be found in the original by-law and in each of its amendments.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1. No one residing outside the municipality may carry on any trade or business in the municipality without being previously authorized thereto by a permit.

More particularly, but without restricting the generality of the foregoing, a permit is required for the following commercial activities:

- a) landscaping;
- b) snow removal in garage driveways.

ARTICLE 2. *The application for a permit must be submitted on the form supplied by the Town attached to the present By-law as "Annex A" to form an integral part thereto. If the application is correctly completed, the permit is issued by a person designated for this purpose by the Municipal Council.*

ARTICLE 2.1 *No permit shall be issued unless and until permit fees in the amount of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) have been paid to the Treasurer.*

ARTICLE 3. When a vehicle is used for the purposes of a commercial activity in the municipality, the name, address and telephone number of the person operating this business must be legibly inscribed on both sides of the vehicle.

ARTICLE 4. No one may carry on a commercial activity, on a parcel of land or in a building which is owned or occupied by the Town, without a specific authorization of the Town.

ARTICLE 5. Anyone contravening a provision of this by-law, or tolerating or permitting such a contravention, commits an infraction and is liable to the following fine:

- a) for a first infraction: a minimum of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.) and a maximum of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.),
- b) for a repeat infraction: a minimum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.) and a maximum of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.).

ARTICLE 6. *The enforcement of this By-law shall be the responsibility of the Montreal Urban Community Police Officers and of the Hampstead Public Security Officers.*

ARTICLE 7. The present by-law comes into force according to law.
