**BY-LAW NO. 1015**

**BY-LAW ON THE PUBLICATION OF THE  
LEGAL PUBLIC NOTICES BY THE TOWN OF  
HAMPSTEAD.**

---

**WHEREAS** notice of motion of the present By-law was given at a special council meeting held on July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017;

**WHEREAS** a draft By-law was adopted at the special Council Meeting held on July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017;

**WHEREAS** all Council members received a copy of the By-law No. 1015 and declare having read it;

**WHEREAS** the Assemblée nationale du Québec adopted the law entitled *An act mainly to recognize that municipalities are local governments and to increase their autonomy and powers (2017, chapter 13)*;

**WHEREAS** this Act permits the adoption by a municipality of a By-law to determine the modalities of publication of its public notices;

**WHEREAS** the *Cities and Towns Act* was modified accordingly;

**WHEREAS** any By-law to this effect must provide for publication on the internet;

**WHEREAS** it is in the interest of the Town of Hampstead to adopt such a By-law;

**ON AUGUST 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2017, THE COUNCIL DECREES THE FOLLOWING:**

**SECTION 1**

All the legal public notices of the Town of Hampstead will be published on a special section of the web site of the Town and will also be posted on the board of the Town Hall and this without any obligation of publication in a local newspaper;

**SECTION 2**

If necessary and for any reason deemed valid by the Town, a public notice may also be published in a local newspaper in addition to the publication mentioned in section 1 of the present By-law;

**SECTION 3**

All the legal time limits for the publication of public notices must be respected and the Town Clerk will sign a certificate that the public notices have been published on the Town's website on the date mentioned in the notice;

**SECTION 4**

This By-law shall come into force according to the law.
