**BY-LAW No 1008**

---

**BY-LAW RESPECTING THE SPEED LIMITS  
ON FLEET ROAD**

---

WHEREAS paragraph 4 of the first paragraph of Article 626 of the Code of Highway Safety (R.S.Q., c C-24.2.) Allows a municipality to set by regulation the minimum or maximum speed of road vehicles in its territory;

WHEREAS a notice of motion of this By-law was duly given at a meeting of Council of the Town of Hampstead held May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016;

**ON JUNE 14<sup>TH</sup> 2016, THE COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:**

**ARTICLE 1**

This By-law has the title By-law respecting the speed limits on Fleet Road;

**ARTICLE 2**

No person shall drive a road vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 km/h on Fleet Road and this notwithstanding any provision of any other By-law to that effect;

**ARTICLE 3**

Appropriate signage will be installed by the Public Works Department;

**ARTICLE 4**

Every person who contravenes article 2 of this By-law commits an offense and is liable to a fine under section 516 or 516.1 of the Highway Safety Code;

**ARTICLE 5**

This By-law shall enter into force 90 days after its adoption, unless they have been a disavowal from the Transport Minister published in the Gazette officielle du Québec.
